**I. Judicial Intern Hiring Update**

**Judge Choudhury's chambers is currently hiring two judicial interns for Summer 2026. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis until the positions are filled.**

Interested candidates should keep in mind the following information:

The internship will run roughly from mid-May to mid-August, with exact dates to be determined based on candidates' law school calendars and availability.

Interns will work with Judge Choudhury's judicial law clerks. Interns' duties will include: assisting clerks with legal research and drafting; citation checking, Bluebooking, and finalizing orders for filing; and other substantive and administrative tasks that arise in chambers.

Judge Choudhury's chambers welcomes and encourages applications from people with a demonstrated commitment to public service.

Judge Choudhury's chambers is located in **Central Islip, Long Island** – close to parks, beaches, nature, and hiking trails. Interns are expected to work in chambers in Central Islip five days per week. Several times a month, interns will join Judge Choudhury and her law clerks working in chambers in Brooklyn.
