11 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no party in a criminal case shall submit
12 more than five (5) letters regarding sentencing unless authorized by the court for
13 good cause shown.

14 Additional letters may be submitted to the probation officer who is preparing
15 the presentence report for summarization in the report. Counsel may also submit
16 to the court as part of a sentencing memorandum a brief summary of letters in
17 excess of the amount authorized by this order. Any letters submitted to the court
18 must be filed no later than five (5) days prior to sentencing and must be typed in at
19 least 14-point font. The Court shall strike from the record any letters filed or
20 submitted in violation of this order and they shall not be made available to the
21 court for review. Thus, any letters submitted in violation of this order shall not be
22 read by the court or be part of the record.
