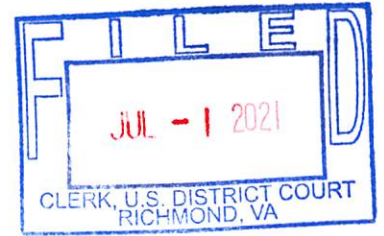




**STANDING ORDER**

Effective immediately, if all parties in a Social Security Appeal consent to have the matter heard by a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), the matter shall be reassigned to United States Magistrate Judge Mark C. Colombell for all purposes. If the parties do not consent to have the matter heard by a United States Magistrate Judge, the case shall be referred to Judge Colombell for Report and Recommendation pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B).
